Mr. Hemmings, who was 82 years of age, was one of the old Morris dancers, and he and his brother James, who is six years his junior, were leading personalities in the old June revels. For several generations it was customary on 20 June to elect a "Mayor of Ock-street" at the Ock-street Horns, the "Mayor" being elected by ballot, and for years Mr. William Hemmings was the popular choice. That evening the party used to dance from the bottom of Ock-street to the "Cock and Tree," and on the following day the party, consisting of 11 persons, with the "mace" and "cup," went round the town giving dancing displays. Mr. William Hemmings was a concertina player and his brother was a dancer. On 5 May, 1910, they gave a programme at the Kensington Town Hall, at the time when Morris dancing was being revived. In 1922 a collection was taken up for the purchase of a concertina at the Kensington Town Hall by the English Folk Dancing Society, and this was subsequently presented to Mr. William Hemmings. Of late years he lost the sight of an eye, through a thorn, and eventually this affected the sight of the other eye. In his early days he worked on the railway, and afterwards for Mr. Budgett.
