They were further charged with being on the premises during prohibited hours. - Mr. Superintendent Brabner stated that about ten minutes past twelve o'clock, he was on duty near Bury-lane, when he heard very bad language being used, and some disturbance, which he found proceeded from the "Black Swan" Inn. He went to the door, and when he knocked it was opened by the wife of the landlord, who asked him to turn out the defendants. Both defendants were drunk, and so also was the landlord of the house. A man named Smith was also present, but he was not drunk.
